Desired skills include: excellent vocal, instrumental and worship leadership; organization, communication, and leadership proficiency; ability to map chord structures and rhythms to create a unified and tight sound among musicians; experience in leading contemporary and traditional praise music; knowledge of various praise and worship music styles with particular emphasis on contemporary praise; familiarity with sound system technology.

This person will work closely with volunteers to maximize their musical talents. The ideal candidate will exhibit spiritual maturity, a dynamic personality, an ability to direct and relate well to a variety of ages, and the desire to grow the worship and praise music program as our congregation grows. We are looking for creativity in trying new and different things, and desire to implement occasional projects/activities to reach out into our community as well. The position will require an average of about 10 hours per week.
