Job Opening: Youth Director

Purpose: To develop and implement a program of spiritual formation for the youth at First Presbyterian.

Accountability: The Youth Director is accountable to the Minister, the Christian Education Commission and the Personnel Committee.

Responsibilities:

1. Develop and expand sustainable youth programs to guide and nurture youth toward enrichment and closer relationships with God and one another.
2. Develop, plan, and implement social "fun" events, mission events, education/study events, and involvement in worship and the arts.
3. Conduct a regularly scheduled weekly meeting at the church for middle School and high school youth, as well as attend First Presbyterian worship services.
4. Work with the youth, parents, and minister to develop an annual youth program and schedule.
5. Plan, publicize, produce, and perform in an annual Youth Sunday.
6. Work with the youth and related parties to coordinate fundraising activities.
7. Assist in and facilitate recruitment and retention of additional youth at First Presbyterian.
8. Be reliable for the youth as someone they know cares about each of them.
9. The expectation is that the Youth Director's position will involve five to ten hours a week year round; the salary is negotiable.

Evaluation:

A performance review and goal setting will be conducted by the Minister and a member each from the Personnel and Christian Education Committees.

Preferred Qualifications:

*Be a practicing Christian as well as being knowledgeable about the Reformed tradition.

*Must be over 21 years of age.
