

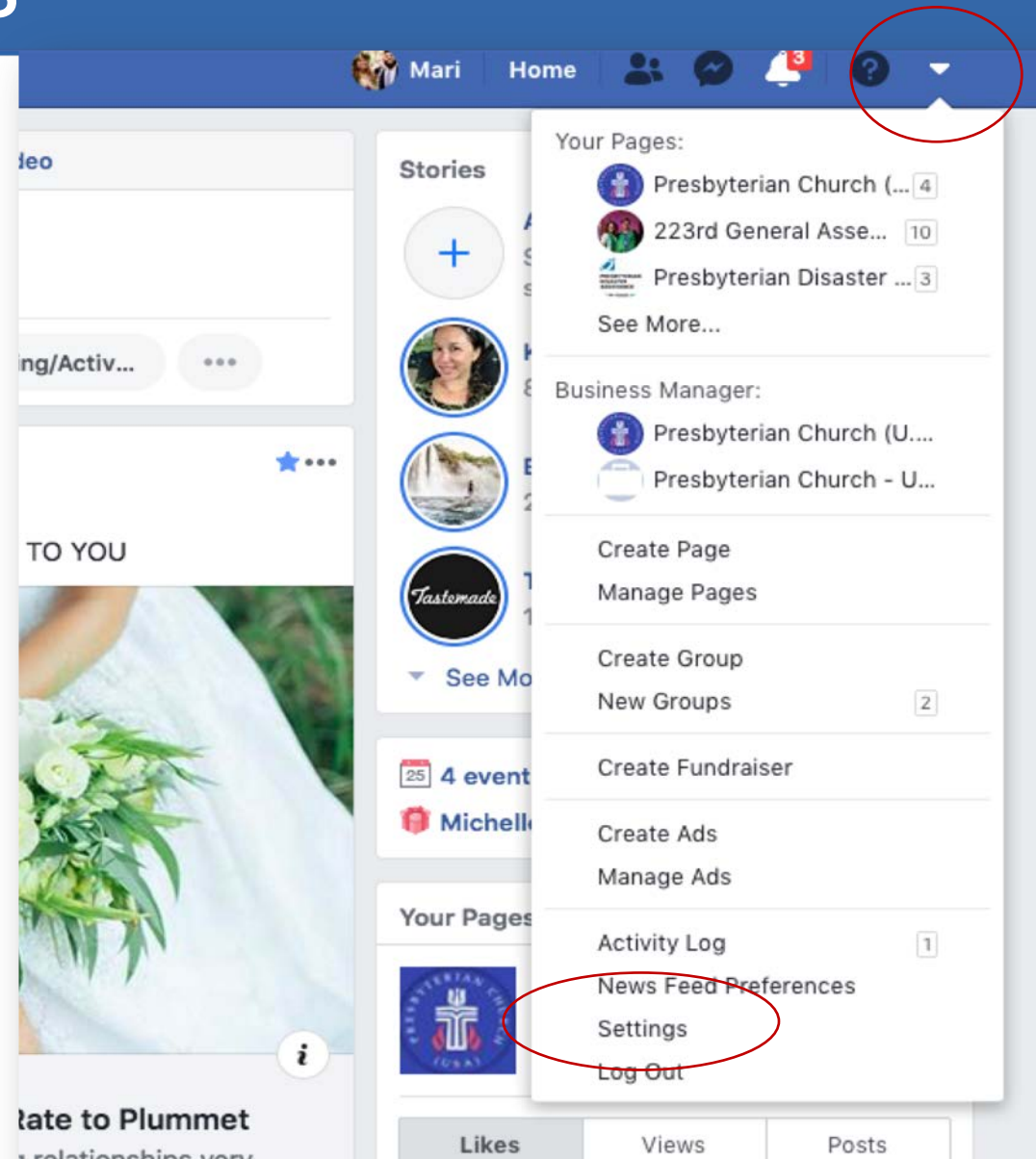


Facebook Tagging Settings

- Make adjustments to tagging on this page. To be able to review all tagged posts of you before they are posted to your Facebook feed, click "Edit," then "Enable."
