- Getting out and enjoying the natural wonders of the region: Klamath Basin National Wildlife Refuges; Lava Beds National Monument and Crater Lake National Park; vistas with snow crested volcanoes and large lakes; Seasons that are distinct with their benefits and challenges
- Not having to be too formal, having a sense of humor, and being adaptable to circumstance

### **What specific tasks, assignments, and program areas will this person have responsibility?**

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Responsibilities include:

- Worships and sacraments; encouraging and training members to help with worship services; Worship services that are inviting to the old and young
- Pastoral visitations and outreach
- Christian Education for all ages. Having enough Biblical insight to challenge adults, interest youth, and spiritually shape children
- " Head of Staff" for a small staff and volunteers.
- Being accessible and able to provide personal counseling
