Not All Splitters are equal

If you are going to be starting hybrid worship soon and you use presentation software for worship, you may want to split your presentation computer video signal so that people online and people in the sanctuary can see your presentation at the same time. You may be able to accomplish this by purchasing a simple HDMI splitter. However, not all splitters are equal. Since there are a number of HDMI resolutions that can be present on projectors, TV screens and computer capture cards, you may find that a mismatch will allow you to display video on one device but not on the other. To solve this, you need a splitter that will allow you to adjust the resolution on each HDMI output your splitter provides. The KanexPro splitter has 4 switches on the front that allows you to set a variety of output resolution combinations. This may solve the resolution issues that you have with your streaming and projecting system. See the information below on the KanexPro SP-HD.



KanexPro SP-HD Overview

Send one HDMI signal to up to four displays with the **KanexPro 1x4 HDMI Splitter**. This splitter can be used to transmit content protected by HDCP, useful for Blu-ray discs and other HD content. Resolutions up to 4K are supported on inputs and outputs. The unit is built in a metal enclosure and comes with a power supply so it's ready to be used right out of the box. This version has an EDID mode for applying a set display resolution from one output to all the outputs.
